P FARO02: Description of the Institution's grading system

The result achieved in a course unit whether through continuous assessment or in an examination, is generally expressed in a 0 to 20 grading scale.

The lowest passing grade is 10.

ECTS credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

1 trimester = 20 credits

ECTS grading scale:

ECTS scale	% of the successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
A	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	25	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors
C	30	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of errors
D	25	SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL - some work required before the criteria can be awarded
F	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required


Termination or Modification of the Agreement

The present bilateral agreement will be valid during the academic years 2014/15 – 2020/21, unless either side terminates the agreement in writing at the latest by September 30th for activities taking place during the next (n+1) academic year. Additional activities, cancellations or new subject areas are to be communicated by the same deadline.

In the event of unilateral termination or modification, a notice one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
